Section 1: Topic Background

- Provide a brief explanation on the topic being discussed within the committee.

Section 2: Past UN, Organization, or Country Involvement

- Describe any past United Nations, or if your committee is not a UN Body, the previous actions of that body on the topic. Delegates may also include any past involvement their country has had within the subject.

Section 3: Country Policy and Proposed Solutions

- Provide an overview of your allocations position and policies on the topic. Delegates should feel free to include potential solutions they plan to implement within committee as long as they do not bring them as prewritten solutions to committee sessions. This should be the longest section of the paper.

Works Cited:

Delegates must cite all sources utilized within their Position Papers. Failure to do so may result in expulsion from COCMUN 2022. The works cited page should be on a separate page at the end of the paper and does not contribute to the 1 page maximum length requirement. Delegates may include sources for both topics on one page as long as they indicate which topic each source belongs to.
