

## Technical Theatre AA (Associates GE Track)

+If you have completed coursework at another college and/or are starting in a semester other than a Fall term, please follow up with the Counseling Department to determine if this sequence is appropriate for your academic and career goals.

**Program Description:** The Technical Theatre program is designed to provide basic academic and practical training in technical theatre at the entry level for resident and touring theatres, theme parks, television and motion picture students or for students to transfer to a four-year school. Students may work on theatrical carpentry, lighting, costume construction etc.

**Program SLO:** 1) Demonstrate professional behavior as part of team implementing technical theater elements for a production 2) Demonstrate safe construction and installation techniques for technical theatre disciplines such as scenery, lighting, or costumes 3) Analyze a script, paying particular attention to technical elements
