## CNA-Certified Nursing Assistant - Certificate of Specialization

+If you have completed coursework at another college and/or are starting in a semester other than a Fall term, please follow up with the Counseling Department to determine if this sequence is appropriate for your academic and career goals.

**Program Description:** Upon completion of this course and a state test for certification, the student will be able to function as a certified nurse assistant in a skilled nursing facility providing basic patient care for residents. The CNA works under the supervision of a licensed vocational nurse or registered nurse.

**Program SLO:** Students will be able to demonstrate proficiency in the core skills and knowledge required for employment as a certified nurse assistant.

NOTE: In order to register for the NURS 050-Nurse Assistant Training Course, a Pre-Admittance Packet must be picked up from the Health Professions and Public Safety Office (BONH 243A).
