Mr. Schrage provided an oral summary of building projects remaining on the Valencia campus for the Committee members:

- Library Expansion
 - ✓ Anticipated completion: May 2011
 - ✓ Open: Fall 2012
 - ✓ Cost: 60% of original estimate (saved \$5 M for the State & \$3 M for the district)
- Administration/Student Services
 - ✓ Preliminary plans: Expected completion next week
 - ✓ DSA: One week later (takes approximately 6 months)
 - ✓ Out for bid: March or April 2012
- Culinary Arts
 - ✓ Working drawings: In progress
 - ✓ DSA: December 2011
 - ✓ Last new building on Valencia campus
- Re-modernization of existing facilities is all that is left for the Valencia campus.

Ms. Coleal reviewed the Life to Date Expenses report for the Committee.

Review of Life to Date Expenses by Project (4.1)

Ms. Coleal informed the Committee of the District's intent to issue additional bonds in spring 2012. She explained how the process works and informed the Committee that a resolution to issue additional bonds would be presented to the Board of Trustees.

Issuance of Future GO Bonds and Measure M Projects (4.2)

Dr. Van Hook explained to the Committee that only the needed portion of the remaining bond funds would be issued. When Bond funds are issued, they must be spent within three years to avoid arbitrage. The District hopes to time issuances to provide additional benefit to the District.
