NETECH-150	Network Fundamentals (CompTIA Network+)	NETECH-150 (Network+ Certification Prep) will satisfy a necessary touchstone for the future Systems Administrator AS and the Existing Cybersecurity AS; Network Fundamentals. Currently, the only course we offer to this end is NETECH-151 CCNA1, the first of 3 CCNA courses aimed specifically at those in the Network Engineering track. NETECH-151 is highly rigorous, vendor-specific, and inflexibly focused on a continuation down the three-course sequence, which may be a disservice to students with alternative trajectories to future Network Engineers. NETECH-150 however, is an agnostic approach to our network fundamentals requirements, affords students readiness to achieve an Industry-Recognized Certification (IRC) in a single term, and is a reasonable alternative for students without the need for CCNA's nuanced emphasis.
