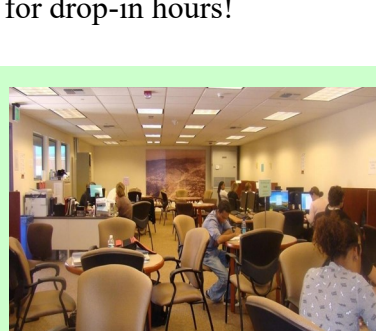

Campus Safety Reminders

When driving through Campus, please be aware of pedestrians, both in the parking lots and crossing the streets. Crosswalks are marked with signs, and soon will have "Yield" signs. Please follow posted speed limits and be courteous to other drivers. As a pedestrian, please watch for cars that may not see you, use the crosswalks and pedestrian sidewalks. Together, we can avoid accidents and make our campus safe for all.

Important traffic reminders:

- Student parking is available in Lots 1, 2, and 3, and a student parking permit is required at all times.
- Daily permits are available from one of our three parking ticket machines in campus lots 1, 2 and 3
- Our campus is a one way only road from entry to exit. Please follow posted street signs.
- Pickup/drop off of students is allowed at the designated white curbs only. Parking or stopping at red curbs causes traffic to back up and it's a fire code violation.
- No parking on Dr. Dianne G. Van Hook Dr. (formerly Campus Dr.). The road is closed due to the Science building construction.
- Marked Green curbs are for 30 minute parking only, unless the designated time is posted differently.
- Please be careful of where you walk on Cougar Way, due to the construction, there may be equipment and debris in the area.

Frequently Asked Questions

Whether you are new to CCC, or a returning student, we are here to help. Please check out our website's frequently asked questions at www.canyons.edu/offices/ccc/pages/faq.aspx, for questions and answers pertaining to students attending classes at CCC.

What support services are available on campus? The goal of the Canyon Country Campus is to provide students with services similar to those offered at the Valencia Campus. For a list of campus support services/departments and hours, check out the support service schedule online at www.canyons.edu/offices/ccc/pages/hours.aspx.

Do I need a parking permit? Student parking permits are required each day. Students must always park in student lots. Permits are available **ONLINE ONLY** through your MyCanyons account located at www.canyons.edu. When you purchase your permit online a 10-day Canyon Country parking permit will be sent to you via email for use until your permanent permit is delivered. Instructions for purchasing parking permits are found online at www.canyons.edu/offices/CampusSafety/pages/ParkingRegulations.aspx. Daily permits may be purchased for \$3.00/day from the black vending machines located at the entrance of Lots 1 and 2, and in front of the building 1A in Lot 3.

Where can I get a student ID card? Student ID cards can be made in the ASG Computer Lounge (room 204). First student ID is free and a replacement ID is \$5 (cash or check only!). It is free if you come to the lounge in the last 2 hours that it is opened. We also do employee badges as well as student badges (EMT, Nursing, Phlebotomy, etc.).

Where can I print on campus? Printers are available for student use in the Library (307), TLC (306), Student Study Room (302) for a small fee. Print cards can be purchased in TLC (306) or the Student Study Room (302). Limited free printing is available in the ASG Student Lounge (204) and Student Services Computer Lab (building 1B). Students can have 15 FREE Black and White pages as well as 5 free color pages per day to print out. Color printers are not available in all labs.

Is there an ATM on campus? Yes, an ATM is available in the Vending Café in room 303. The Vending Café is open Monday - Thursday 7:30am - 9:00pm and Friday 7:30am - 4:00pm.

Are there food services available on campus? Yes, The Café is open Monday through Thursday, from 7:30 am to 7:00 pm (hours subject to change). Sodas, water, chips and snacks are available from vending machines in the Vending Café (room 303) Monday through Thursday 7:30am to 9:00pm.

Is there a bookstore on campus? We currently do not have a bookstore at the Canyon Country Campus, however books can be ordered online and shipped to your home for free using promo code **BNCFREE-SHIP**. Scantrons and Blue Books can be purchased in the Vending Café (Room 303).

Food Pantry: Visit the Counseling Office and/or Student Health Center at CCC to connect you with needed resources.
