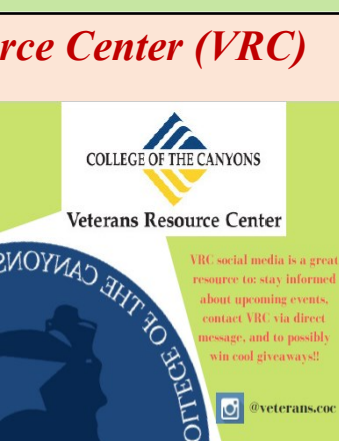
## Veteran's Resource Center (VRC)

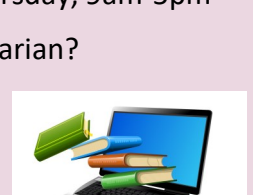


## The Library

Come and visit us! Services include computer and wi-fi access, printing, comfortable study tables and chairs, and of course, BOOKS (including textbooks).

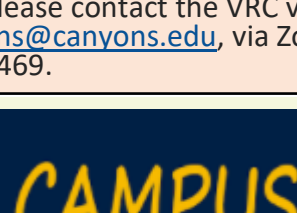
