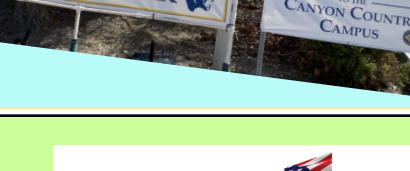
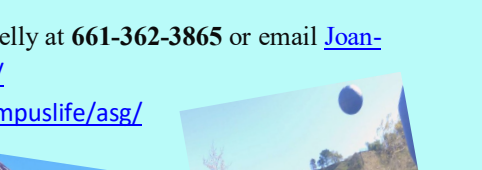
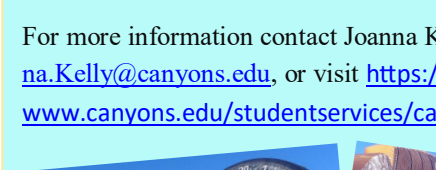

Pathway To Law School Information Meeting

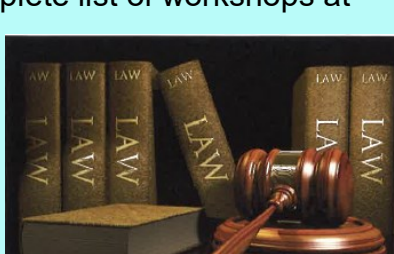

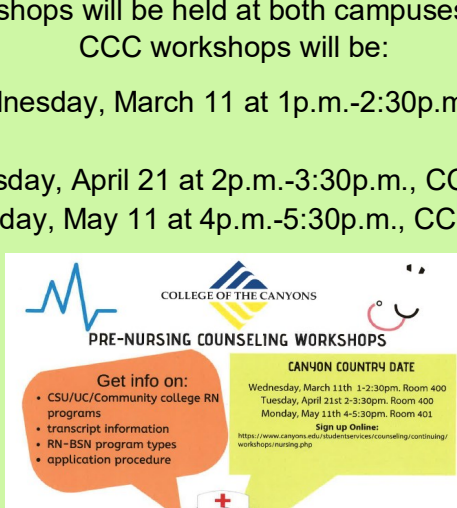

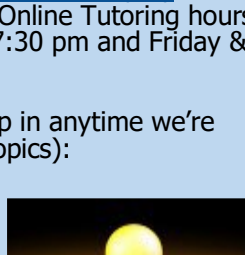
TLC - The Learning Center
