Do you have an immediate question for a counselor?— Express Drop-in counseling is an opportunity to meet with a counselor for a short 10-15 minute consultation to address quick questions. Will you have your Associate's degree completed by Spring 2021? If so, be sure to petition for your degree early so you may qualify for spring 2021 graduation priority enrollment consideration. The deadline is Friday, February 11, 2021, however if you submit your petition by December 18, 2020, you will be considered for priority enrollment for spring registration if you select this option on your graduation petition. 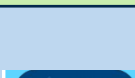

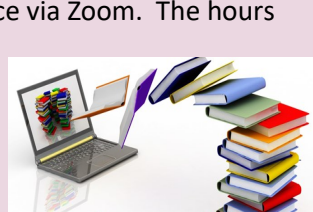
The Library
