## What is Liberal Arts and Sciences?

The Liberal Arts and Sciences major at COC is designed for students planning to transfer to either the California State University or University of California. To earn the Associate in Arts degree with a Liberal Arts and Sciences major, students must complete either the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) UC or CSU option or the CSU General Education Certification pattern and one of the three areas of emphasis. The area of emphasis requires a minimum of 18 units with a grade of "C" or better in all courses in the area of emphasis. The areas of emphasis are:
