ASG Grant applications are due on **Friday, April 15, 2022 by 12pm**. Consider filling out the [ASG Grant Application](#) with your fellow club officers and club advisor. Chartering Forms 2022-2023

Club chartering forms for the 2022 – 2023 year will be available starting **Friday, April 15, 2022 at 9am**. Your club will be ready to fill out this form if you pertain to any of the following.

1. Club Information Form
 - a. You already know who the officers will be starting Fall 2022.
 - b. One person can hold more than one club officer position.
 - c. If you know of at least one officer returning, please fill out the Club Information with this person's information so that they receive the monthly club update e-mails starting in August 2022.
2. Advisor Agreement Form
 - a. Your club advisor has already agreed to continue advising the club for 2022 – 2023.
3. Membership Form
 - a. You will be attaching this form to the Club Information Form
 - b. Please fill this form out to your best ability with information of club members intending to return in 2022 – 2023. This form can be updated later in Fall 2022 and resubmitted once the club has established more members. There is no requirement for a minimum number of members for returning clubs (new clubs will need at least 7 members).
4. Club Constitution
 - a. You will be attaching this document to the Club Information Form.
 - b. Please be sure to review the [Constitution Guidelines](#) and make sure that the mandatory statements are included in your club's constitution.

Rechartering Program

The Rechartering Program is MANDATORY for all clubs in order to become chartered. Clubs will receive 10 ICC points for attending. The purpose of this one-hour workshop is to get all club officers acquainted with club regulations and to answer any questions they may have in order to run the club successfully. Currently, the program is scheduled for **Monday, April 18, 2022 at 2pm** via Zoom. Calendar invitations will be sent to all current club officers. If you are not going to be returning as a club officer next year, but do not have someone replacing your role, we ask that you strongly consider attending in order to pass down information to new officers once they have been determined.
