Background: Melinda Ursetta will be presenting on how Club Funds work, how you can access them, and how you can fundraise to add to them.

-Taking leave in November and will review money handling for clubs

-Each club has own account with ASG if you are a charted club

-All funds may be put in this account and checks may be cut on behalf of your club

-Checks payable to SCCCD ASG for depositing checks into your club account

-Funds prior to Covid is still in accounts and you may request the amount through Melinda

-For grant questions from last year, please check with Melinda

- -Deposit funds- start with filling out the deposit form and may access the form in office or online at the club information on the website
- -Cash box is available upon request along with petty cash
- -Form to request the cash box is available in Campus Life in STCN102
- -Fundraising- two types of fundraising (cheat sheet on website available)
- -Facility request would be needed for bake sales along with food permit
- -Vendor gives a discount price for product- fundraising Activities Worksheet would then be needed as well as for any restaurant fundraiser

- -Must first obtain approval for fundraising with a business
- -Food Permit is attached with the facility request
- -Suggestions for bringing more of a profit-ASL used to make Wacky Waffles and made a good profit from this fundraiser
- -Bake sales do well as students tend to buy baked goods frequently
- -Not allowed to have any off-campus bank account for your club
- -Taking in cash or checks only at the moment but working on offering other payment options
- -If your club goes inactive for 3 semesters in a row, the funds may be transferred into a different club account and are no longer accessible
- -Matching Funds- Fundraise up to \$300 a form may be completed to have ASG match the funds -If you received a Grant for this year, the club would not be able to utilize the Matching Funds
- option.
- -The amount you may apply for fluctuates
- -Grants have been awarded for this year and this year applicants would be used during the next year
- -Fundraising cheat sheet is under the club forms on the website as well as the form for matching funds
- -If a donation is a substantial amount to the club, you should go through the Foundation to obtain the tax ID number first
- -Questions may be directed to Collin or staff from Campus Life
- -Melinda is here until 4:30 pm today and is working from home Tuesday and Thursday
